CRAZ Boundary Change

The Calgary Region Airshed Zone (CRAZ) is pleased to announce the expansion of their northern border, extending the CRAZ zone. CRAZ monitors, analyzes and provides air quality education to the region which includes the City of Calgary, Towns of Banff, Airdrie, Strathmore and Crossfield. This border expansion means that CRAZ will provide air quality knowledge and expertise to all areas encompassed in the M.D of Bighorn and Rocky View County.

CRAZ would like to acknowledge and extend our gratitude to the Parkland Airshed Management Zone (PAMZ) for offering this expansion opportunity. The ten Airsheds in Alberta work together as part of the Alberta Airshed Council to maintain a high quality of air quality management. PAMZ has also generously donated a wind tower for use by CRAZ for the Portable Air Monitoring Lab (PAML). The PAML is currently deployed in the Town of Cochrane, while on a 4-year deployment around the CRAZ region.
